You can create an account for free and get regular alerts by email or phone to tell you when you are volunteering. You can also log into SignUp Genius and change your schedule as much as you need to – Go to the Calendar Tab in your account to change or delete your sign ups!

1. Kickoff, Finale and all of the Summer Events! Kickoff and Finale, our two BIGGEST events of the season! We need every YSG member available to sign up for shifts June 16 and July 26.
