No longer restricted by expensive ticket costs, formal attire, and the need to sit perfectly still, this concert has become a beloved library tradition by guests of all ages each June. This year, CDL is thrilled to add an additional children's concert to the day's events.

Jacopo & Maddalena Giacomuzzi have performed concerts for the CDL audience since 2017. Born in Italy to a family of pianists, both took an interest in music from an early age; when Jacopo became serious about the piano, younger sibling Maddalena was soon to follow. While their style and application are different, their continued love of music and astonishing talent are shared. Both Jacopo and Maddalena Giacomuzzi gained recognition in several national and international competitions and have performed as soloists and chamber musicians in multiple major international music festivals.
